For members 15 years old & not able to attend at least 75% of club and/or Project Meetings. To be eligible, member must have taken the Market Animal Project at least twice.

- Special Projects** **A one page write-up on EACH special project including the date, location, what was seen and explanation of the event is required.**
- Special Project Presentation** **5 Minute presentation at a project or club meeting reflecting ONE of the completed special projects - Presentation must be completed prior to the Easter Beef Show & Sale.**

4-H Year Completion

The following must be on display at the Club Achievement Day in order to complete the 4-H year

- Complete the **PCR's (Project Completion Requirements)** as outlined above
- Complete a **Communication** (public speaking) Project
- Complete a **Community Service** Activity
- Complete an **Agriculture Awareness** Activity
- Complete the **Member Documentation** (4) pages found in your Portfolio or on the website
