



# Seasonal Cupcakes

Are you ready to get creative while learning new skills?! In this project, members (& leaders) will have the opportunity to explore:

- ⇒ Decorating cupcakes for different seasons and holidays
- ⇒ How to use tips properly
- ⇒ How to prepare icing and icing bags
- ⇒ Basic modeling with fondant
- ⇒ **PLUS** different topics as chosen by members and leaders - if something is of interest to you...**EXPLORE!**

### Project Requirements

- Picture of member with four cupcakes decorated for the same or different seasons/holidays**
  - Possible themes are listed in project resource. Decorating tips are also suggested.
  - Each cupcake (or all 4) should have a clear theme
- Tip and Border Tray**
  - The tip and border tray uses actual icing to show samples of three (3) tips used to make both single designs and borders.
  - Remember to label each design with the tip number
- Fondant Modeling**
  - Experiment with fondant.

### 4-H Year Completion

The following must be completed/documented by the Club's Achievement Day in order to complete the 4-H year

- Project Requirements** as outlined above
- Communication** (public speaking or demonstration)
- Community Service** Activity
- Agriculture Awareness** Activity
- Member Documentation** (4) pages found in the member's binder **OR** on the 4-H PEI website

### Exhibition Requirements

**Four Cupcakes clearly decorated for a season or holiday theme.**

Members shall exhibit four decorated cupcakes using butter cream (and royal icing, if desired)  
Each cupcake can have its own design (within one theme) or all four can be of the same design (within one theme)

**Members are strongly encouraged to participate in the 4-H Classes at PEI Fairs & Exhibitions.**
